

Botanical Exploration of Baglung Rukum and Dolpa by Alan Elliott

- General collection trip for the Flora of Nepal to Mid-West Nepal.
- 3 weeks travelling north to south from Baglung district through Rukum District, over the main Himalaya ridge line at the Jangla Bhajang 4500m and into the Dolpa District and the transhimalaya.
- 453 collection, 77 families 184 genera collected.
- *Meconopsis* thin on the ground that far west in the Himalaya.
- *Meconopsis paniculata* fairly abundant when it was found in Rukum District
- *Meconopsis horridula* individuals at high altitude but not common also in Rukum.
- Second part of talk was on Adam Stainton in Nepal
- Digitised images at RBGE from his slide archive
- Viewing his video recorded movie from Nepal in 1956 which is very *Meconopsis* orientated
