

MECONOPSIS GROUP SEED EXCHANGE 2017/2018

Welcome to the 2017/18 seed exchange. Please indicate your desiderata by placing a 'X' in the box, and 7 alternatives by placing an 'A' in the box. For UK members there is a nominal charge of £5 per consignment (10 packets) to cover costs. All requests must arrive by **4th December** after which the seed exchange will close.

Seed of *M. delavayi*, *M. punicea* and *M. quintuplinervia* can be requested in advance for August 2018 (assuming that they will be available), **as part of the current 10 packet consignment**. Those wishing to order in advance for next August should include a 2nd class (Large) stamp to cover the additional postage. Ordering seed in advance for next August does not prevent you from ordering the same species in this current year. You may order additional packets of seed, at a charge of 50p per packet, according to availability.

Non-UK members have already paid for their initial seed allocation as part of their annual subscription.

US members must have a 'Small Lots of Seeds' permit, issued by APHIS. You can find details of how to get a permit at: http://www.aphis.usda.gov/import_export/plants/plant_imports/smalllots_seed.shtml

The 'Small Lots' permit is the only one not requiring phytosanitary certification in the UK. Together with your seed request, we need a copy of your permit with the conditions attached to it, and a green and yellow customs quarantine label. You can make your seed selection online, but no seed will be dispatched until we have your permit documents and customs label. We understand that the permit lasts for 3 years and can be re-used.
